Events: ReMap Art Festival, Athens

From 12th September until 30th October 2011, ReMap – the international contemporary art platform – will open to the public in the area of Kerameikos-Metaxourgeio in Athens in tandem

with the Athens Biennial.

Now in its third year, ReMap3 will be a unique meeting place for over 250 artists, art historians and curators from around the world, as well as the local artistic community within the area. The goal is to create an alternative platform for the production and experiencing of contemporary art within the urban context, and to present this in an interactive environment within a cultural framework.

The 50 plus exhibitions and projects will allow visitors to the event to explore the Kerameikos-Metaxourgeio region in an alternative way, allowing them to become part of the leading creative and cultural hub in Athens.

Over the course of 6 weeks, the Athens Municipal Art Gallery, Athens Film Archive, Kunsthalle Athena, The Breder and Rebecca Camhi galleries, the ATOPOS Contemporary Visual Culture (ATOPOS CVC), E.Δ.Ω, Frown Tails, and a host of theatres including the new Synergy-o experimental stage and the internationally renowned Attis Theatre, will be temporarily housed in unused spaces throughout the area.

Far removed from classic exhibition spaces in museums, art fairs and galleries, these spaces are neoclassical and revolutionary, using 1970s buildings, courtyards, vacant plots and even detached balconies as unique show points for the art on display.

This year's programme includes a number of young artists from across the world, as well as institutions presenting their work in Greece for the first time, thus strengthening ReMap's dynamic presence as a platform for emerging artists and institutions on the international contemporary art scene.

Organized by ReMapKM, a not-for-profit organization, entry across the 6 week period is free to the public.
